The BSB41415 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety is designed to give participants practical knowledge and skills to enable the provision of valid and timely Work Health and Safety (WHS) advice and assist with improving safety in the workplace. Individuals are either in a WHS role, or wanting to secure a WHS role, working under limited supervision and may provide leadership and guidance and be responsible for the output of others within a WHS context.

Enrolment checklist

- ☐ You are over 18 years old or over
- ☐ You are competent in written and spoken English (language, literacy and numeracy will be assessed as part of the enrolment process)
- ☐ You are able to attend the scheduled classroom training sessions as per the timetable
- ☐ You will have access to a computer and the internet for the duration of the course
- ☐ You have three years workplace experience in the building and construction industry or civil construction industry.

How long will it take?

The duration of the course is 26 weeks, classes are held twice a week and run for 3.5 hours. You will also need to allow approximately 8 hours a week study time to complete your course work.

Is the course subsidised?

If you meet the eligibility criteria the cost of your course will be delivered with Victorian and Commonwealth Government funding. If you aren't eligible, you can still enrol in the course as a full fee paying student. We have several payment options available. Give us a call to discuss the best option for you.

Participants need to complete 10 units of competency, consisting of 5 core units plus 5 elective units.
